Ganesh Chaturthi Special Virtual assembly was celebrated on 9/9/2021. Tiny tots of class 3 showcased all their immense talents to welcome Ganesha. And also they expressed their love towards Ganesha by doing their "Colourful Ganesh Idol".

India is touted to be the Land of Fairs and Festivals, and the country is set to celebrate one of the biggest festivals in Hinduism, Ganesh Chaturthi. The day is remembered as the birthday of Lord Ganesh, the son of Lord Shiva and Mata Parvati. Often dubbed as the most beloved Hindu God, Ganesha is also identified by the names Vinayaka, Ganapati and Ekadanta (He is greeted with 108 total names).

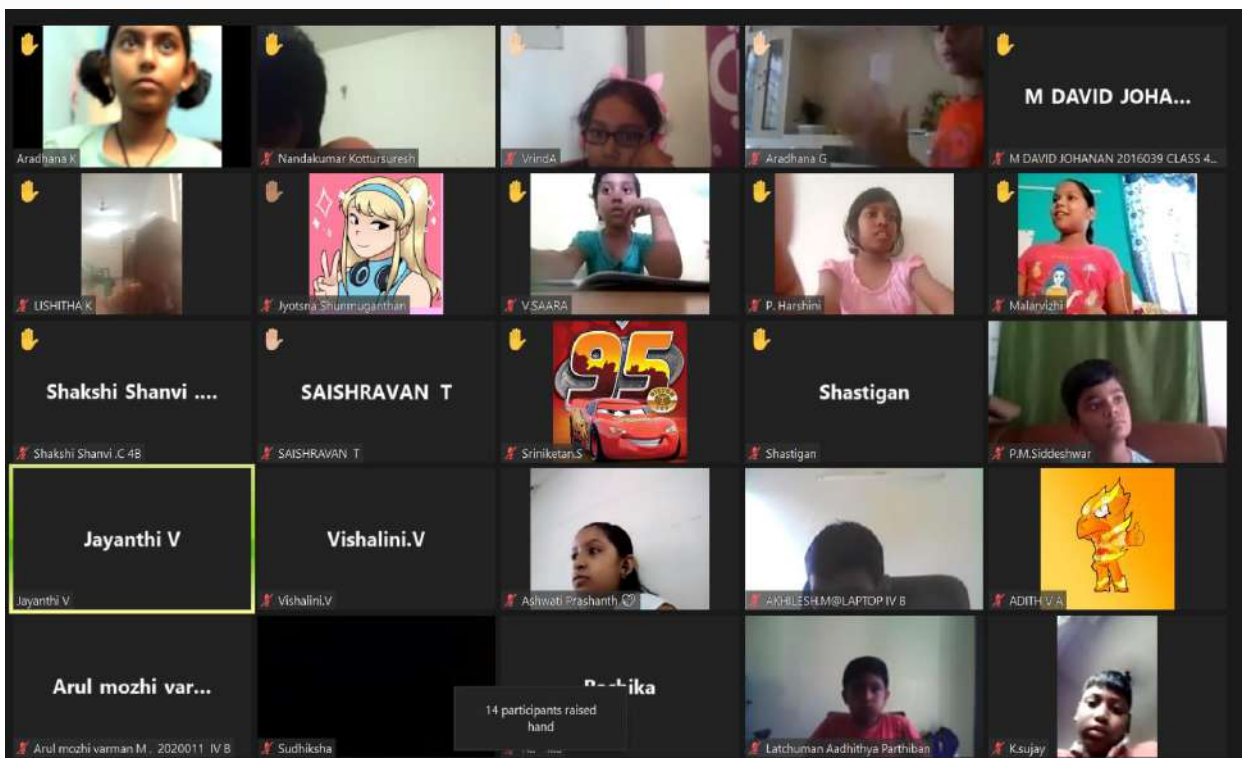
Class:4
