MATHEMATICS DAY

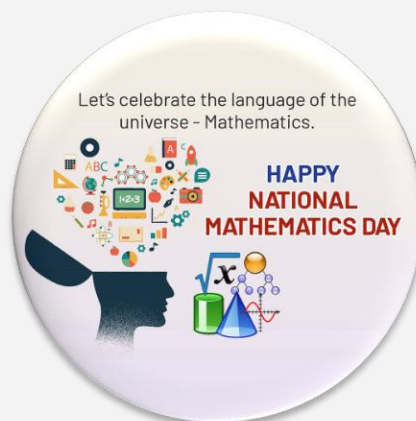
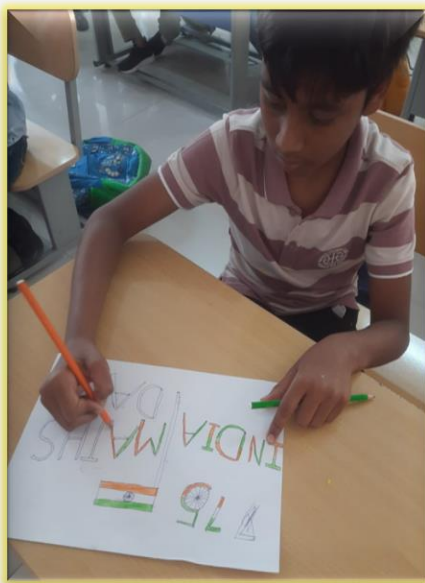
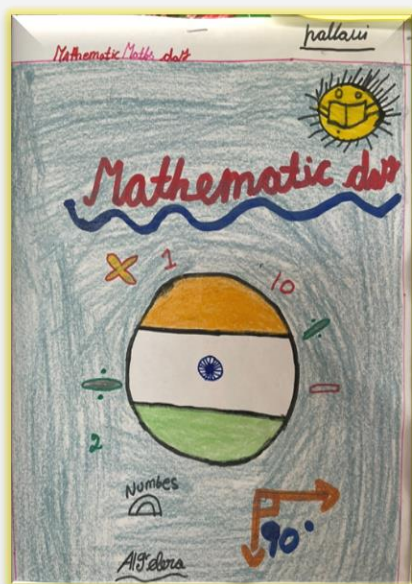
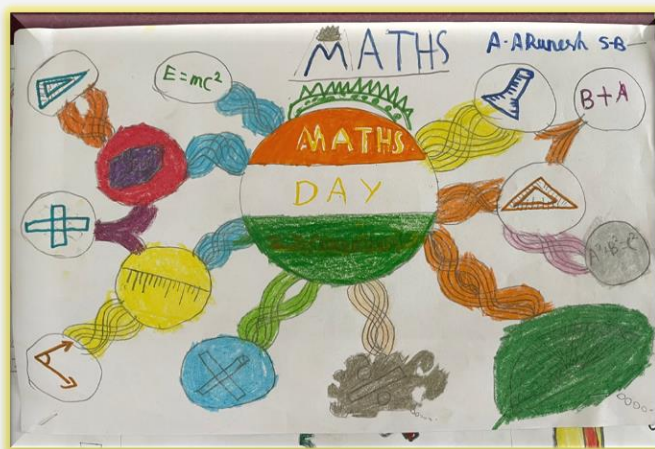
CLASS II - V

CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION CHRIS MOM CHRIS CHILD GAME

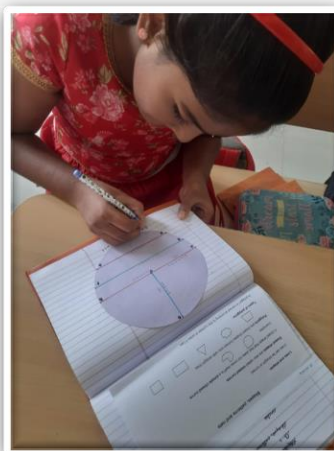
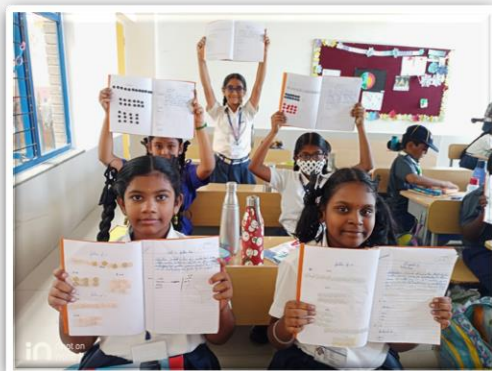
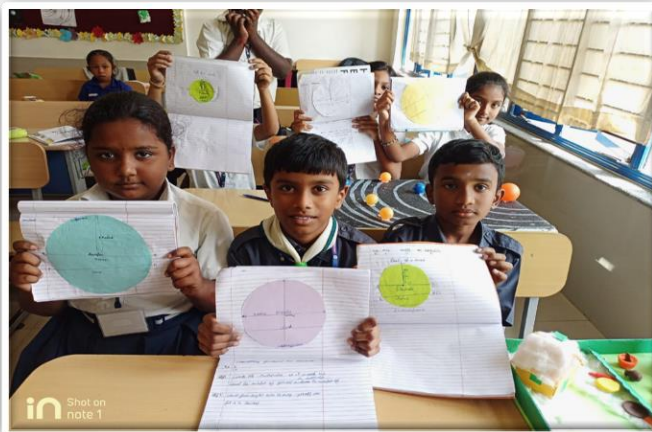

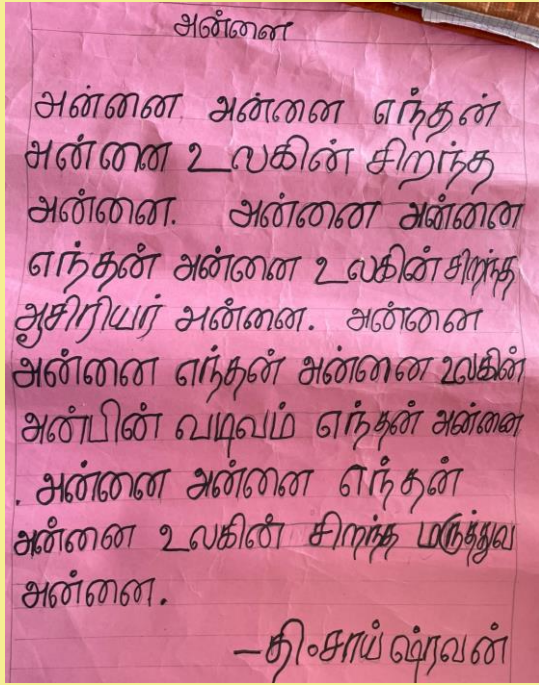
MATH LAB ACTIVITY

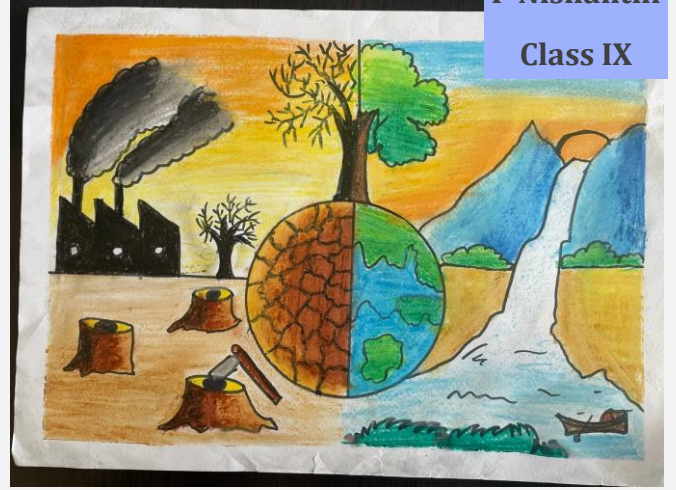

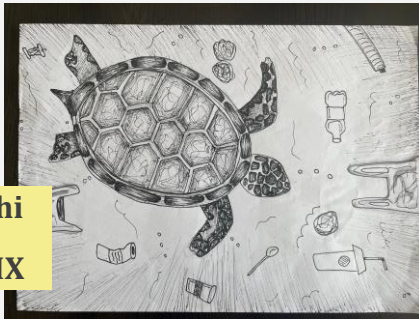

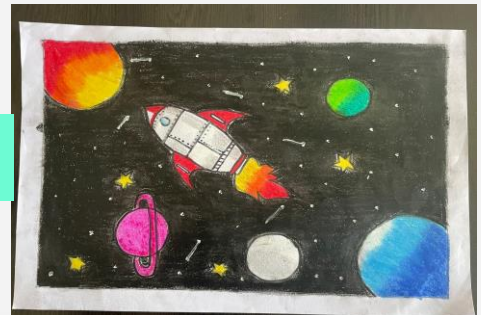
