GANDHI JAYANTHI ASSEMBLY

Mahatma Gandhi or more lovingly known as **BAPU** by all Indians is widely acknowledged as one of the 20th century's most influential people, who employed non-violent resistance to lead the successful campaign for India's independence from British rule. Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi was born on October 2, 1869, in Porbandar, Gujarat. Gandhi was at the forefront of the freedom struggle against British colonial rule and later inspired movements for civil rights and freedom across the world.

On 2nd October every year, Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi's Birth anniversary, known as **Gandhi Jayanti** is celebrated all over India. This day provides an excellent chance for countrymen to pay tribute to this great leader, who gave his life for the country's benefit. To remark on his remembrance, **students of class VII - A of Lightworkers Academy held a special assembly on October 17th 2022. On this day, his 153rd birth anniversary was celebrated.**

The day began with singing his most preferred devotional song by the students of Class 7A '**Raghupati Raaghava Raja Ram**'. The students made drawings, and beautiful slogans, and decorated pinboards with creative items. Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi is widely recognized as one of the twentieth century's greatest political and spiritual leaders. Honoured in India as the father of the nation, he pioneered and practised the principle of Satyagraha—resistance to tyranny through mass nonviolent civil disobedience. Gandhi Jayanthi is also celebrated as the International Day of Non-Violence by the United Nations.

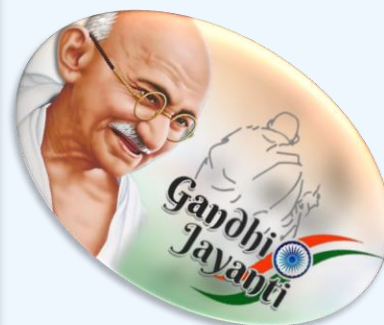
Famous and Thoughtful lines by Gandhi:

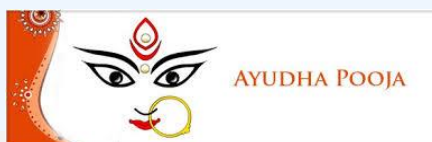

TREE PLANTATION BY OUR TRUSTEE

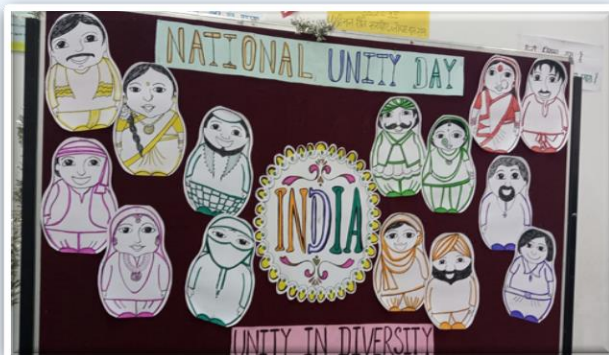


UNITY DAY SPECIAL ASSEMBLY
