
In - House Training on Effective Communication

English language plays a pivotal role in our lives for a multitude of reasons. It facilitates global communication, grants access to information, empowers educational and career opportunities, enriches our understanding of cultures, and fosters personal growth and confidence. English department of LWA had organised an in-house training for our staff on 27 March ,2024 on effective communication. The session started with an activity by Ms Jayanthi, in which the teachers need to translate simple dialogues from Tamil to English followed by Ms Malini explaining the four capabilities that allow an individual to comprehend and produce spoken language for proper and effective interpersonal communication which is Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing. As vocabulary plays a major role in learning language Ms Nivetha had enriched on the topic. Focussing on vocabulary is useful for developing knowledge and skills in multiple aspects of language and literacy. This includes helping with decoding (phonemic awareness and phonics), comprehension, and also fluency. Overall, everyone enjoyed and found this session most useful.
